



Middlings live among others but essentially feel apart from it all.


They often ask themselves this: "Are we just not as happy as those who are much better off in this world?"

If you want them to stop thinking, just give them what they want.






Haee is a middling cat with an unusually long and crooked tail.

Haee never has much to worry about.






Like all cats, Haee is a curious cat.

One day, he decides to venture out.








He comes across a black hole. It looks dangerous and menacing.



Curious and fearless, Haee decides to explore the black hole.






Haee walks for hours.

But he can no longer remember his way home.




